By planting native grass and flower plugs in the water, and scattering native seed above the shoreline, we will be preventing erosion, improving water quality, and enhancing wildlife habitat. Then, take this idea back to your neighborhood, and green your own retention ponds!

We will be planting a small parking lot rain garden at Forest Park (1077 Cicero Road, Noblesville) on the evening of May 20. Join us to gain firsthand knowledge of installing rain gardens and identifying common plant species used in them!
